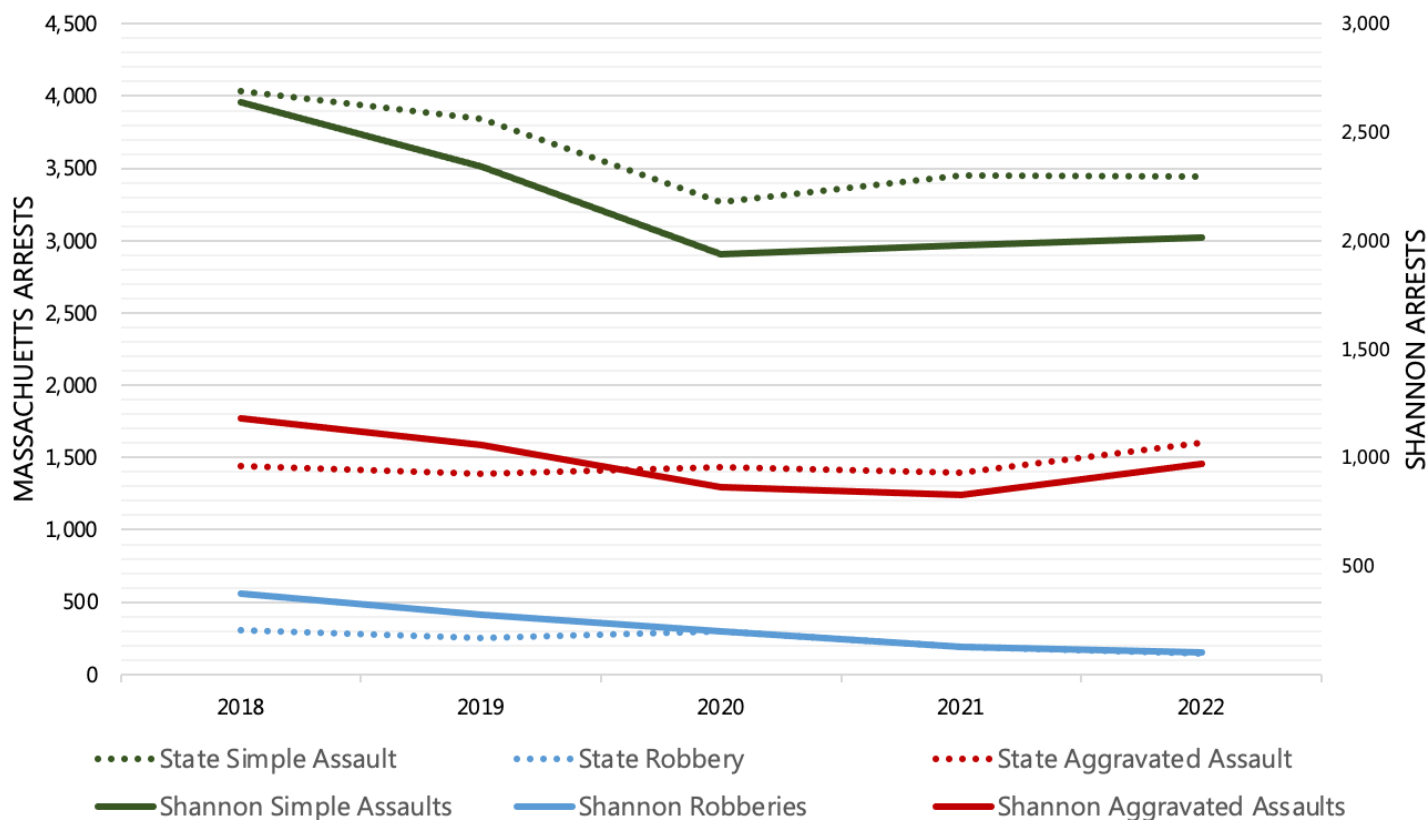

Changes in Crime for Young People Ages 10-24, 2018-2022

Simple assaults in...

- Massachusetts decreased 15%
- Shannon communities decreased 24%

Robberies in...

- Massachusetts decreased 52%
- Shannon communities decreased 73%

Aggravated assaults in...

- Massachusetts increased 11%
- Shannon communities decreased 18%
